

Volunteers are needed for Race Committee and Rescue Boats duty.

Every racing Sunday we will need volunteers to assist on the primary and the Optimist race courses.

On the **Mary Patton**: PRO (Principal Race Officer) and 2 people to help keep time, raise flags, change the course boards and keep records

Safety Boats – Two boats with two people each (a driver and a helper) for setting buoys and for helping racers if they capsize or break down

Finish Boat: Two people to set the finish line and take down the finishes

For the Optimist course:

Committee Boat -PRO and helper to set courses, starts and finishes of races

Safety Boats -To move marks and to help racers when needed

There is a time and a job for everyone regardless of experience!

I would like to have you choose a convenient date so everyone can be included.

Plan ahead and choose a Sunday (or more). Perhaps you will be on the water to watch a family member sail and could do Safety Boat duty at the same time.

If you've always wanted to know how the starting procedure works or how to set a course, this is your opportunity to team up with an experienced member and learn.
